Accurate **pruning techniques** and **timing** are key to the long-term health of your landscape. Disease, insect and structural damage is almost always deterred by making the right decisions when pruning. Some trees and shrubs can be pruned at just about any time of the year. However, most have a small window of opportunity. When this time period is neglected, the result will be fewer blooms and an overall lower quality plant.

Tips from our Mass Certified Horticulturalists

- Prune Azaleas and Rhododendrons after they flower and before they put out their new buds, or they may not flower next spring.
- Maples and Magnolias should be pruned in August or they will bleed.
- Excessive nitrogen and lime from lawn applications may reduce the amount of flowers on your trees and shrubs.
- Mow your grass 3" high to shade itself and encourage deeper roots.
- Apply grub control in mid to late summer.
- Dead head perennials to encourage new flowers and to keep the gardens looking fresh
